Community Sports Leader Award in Archery

Thank you for your enquiry about the above award. It is the minimum level of qualification for people who would like to be involved in introducing people to Archery. It involves a 4 ½ day course, with an oral and practical assessment at the end (½ day).

The course covers:

Learning to shoot using different shooting techniques and learning basic beginners style.
Teaching methods, safety and shooting improvement.
Equipment maintenance, other forms of archery.
Practice and revision, followed by assessment (practical and oral).

Prior registration with the Grand National Archery Society will ensure that each candidate receives an Information Pack. During the course candidates may also receive some handouts, which will be useful and informative.

The fee for group booking for the course is currently:
For 8 people £960 plus £40 registration fee plus £30 per candidate.
For 9 to 12 people £1400 plus £40 registration fee plus £30 per candidate.
(This price is subject to change without notice between courses. Once course is booked the price is guaranteed). Other things that may impact the cost of the course is whether or not you provide your own equipment. Usually if we provide equipment then add £100 to cost of course.

The certificate awarded to successful candidates lasts for 3 years, after which it can be renewed on payment of a renewal fee, which is currently set at £30, and production of evidence that the holder is still involved in introducing people to Archery.
